You will be strategically matched with an experienced CS teacher who will act as your mentor. Together, you'll meet virtually for about one hour, twice per month throughout the school year. During these sessions, you'll plan and reflect on lessons, address challenges, build your knowledge and skills, and monitor your progress toward professional goals.

Through 1:1 mentorship, we expect that you will gain increased confidence, develop pedagogical content knowledge, and enhance your equitable and inclusive teaching practices. Personalized mentoring is completely FREE to CS teachers!

What Will Mentees Do?

- Set and work to achieve two professional learning goals across the year
- Virtually meet 1:1 with your mentor twice per month (about one hour each)
- Virtually meet with other CS teachers three times per year on:
 - Sept. 22nd, Jan. 12th, and May 18th
- Share self-reflections, learning goals, and progress with the project team to help improve the mentoring program and support research activities

Stipend & Time Commitment

- 3 hours per month (Sept. 2026 - May 2027)
- \$500 stipend for full participation, half in Jan. & June 2027
